# PRE-ARRIVAL ARRANGEMENTS



Students from partner institutions wishing to study at "Baltazar Zaprešić" University of Applied Sciences for a semester should contact their home institution's international office and follow local procedures. Once nominated, they must apply by sending the following documents to [international@bak.hr](mailto:international@bak.hr) or by postal mail (Vladimira Novaka 23, 10290 Zaprešić, Croatia):

- Registration Form of the "Baltazar Zaprešić" University of Applied Sciences
- One photo in colour
- Transcript of Records
- OLA - Learning Agreement signed by the student and the respective coordinator in charge at the home institution
- Copy of the ID card or passport (first page with the photo and personal data)
- Optional: proof of language proficiency (minimum B1).

# PRE-ARRIVAL ARRANGEMENTS

## VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMIT

According to the law regarding foreigners, foreign nationals intending to study in Croatia must regulate their temporary residence for the purpose of studying if their stay in Croatia is longer than 90 days.

## MEDICAL INSURANCE

All foreign students must have medical insurance covered during their stay in Croatia. EU nationals must have European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). Non EU nationals should check with the healthcare provider at home and/or their home university.

# PRE-ARRIVAL ARRANGEMENTS

## ACCOMODATION

You can search for private accommodation either in Zaprešić or Zagreb. Prices are approximately 300-400 EUR per month for a single room or 500 for a studio apartment. The offer is better in Zagreb and there is a good public transportation connection to Zaprešić (30 min by bus or train).

Rent is typically paid monthly and in advance. At the start of a letting period it is standard to pay one month's rent, which is refunded provided you don't break any of the terms in the lease.



Utilities are usually not included in the price of the rent, and are paid separately!

## LIVING COSTS

Average monthly living expenses in Croatia are estimated to be between 600 and 800 EUR depending on the type of accommodation, student needs and lifestyle. These amounts should be enough to cover food, accommodation, utilities, books, transportation and miscellaneous expenses.




Welcome days are organized by the International Relations Office at the beginning of each semester to help you get to know each other better.


OIB is issued by the Tax Administration Office. Their address depends on the address of the apartment you rent.

## ASSESSMENT & TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

Exchange students following courses at the "Baltazar Zaprëšić" University of Applied Sciences are expected to undertake the same academic work and type of assessments as home students. The assessment could be done through **exams, exams plus course work, or any other requirement** established by the corresponding teacher.

The **Transcripts of Records** can be obtained during the stay in Zaprëšić and after returning home at any time.

## TRANSPORT



### PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN ZAGREB AND AREA

Public transport in Zagreb and its area is operated by Zagrebački električni tramvaj. There is a well-developed public transportation network both within the city and to connect it with neighboring towns such as Zaprešić.

To get to **Zaprešić**, you first need to take a tram to the **Črnomerec** station. The tram number will depend on the area where you rent an apartment, use Google maps to find out which tram to take (trams 6, 11, 2 are the best). Next, at the Črnomerec station, you need to find the bus platform number 6 from which the bus number **172 "Črnomerec - Zaprešić"** departs (find the schedule at the link below). The nearest stop to the university in Zaprešić is called "Stadion".

You can also use the train departing from Main Railway Station in Zagreb (**Glavni Kolodvor Zagreb**). The train departs every 20 to 30 minutes, with a travel time of 21 minutes. It is best to take the train to the **Zaprešić Savska** station, after which you will need to walk 17 minutes to the university itself.
