A- Aims and Goals of Deanery

Strategic Objective-1: To ensure that the resources allocated to the faculty by the university are used effectively, economically, and efficiently. To create and strengthen sufficient educational staff along with administrative, technological and physical infrastructure.

Goal-1.1.: To ensure that the work and transactions between the units of university, Dean's Office, faculty members and students are carried out in a coordinated manner.

Strategic Purpose-2: To increase the knowledge, skills and motivation of Deanery employees.

Goal-2.1: To increase the motivation of unit staff with social activity programs.

B- Basic Policies and Priorities

Our deanery is a young and dynamic unit in terms of institutional and personnel. The dedication of our staff is our greatest advantage, but we have shortcomings in terms of workspace, IT equipment and technological infrastructure. We strive to eliminate our deficiencies as soon as possible and ensure that the work continues without any disruption during this period.

The studies carried out by the Dean's Office to eliminate the hardware and infrastructure deficiencies are focused on students and research with the understanding of "human first".

The main purpose of the Medium-Term Program, which is the main source of our policies and priorities, is as follows: a Turkey that grows in stability, shares its income more fairly, has competitive power on a global scale, transforms into an information society, and has completed its harmonization process for EU membership. Based on this vision, it is to carry out a program and budget process aimed at improving the quality of life of our people.

Therefore, the priorities of Deanery are;

Making the education and training environment more ergonomic; The Dean's Office aims to improve the physical environment and technological facilities within the scope of its efforts to make the working environment more ergonomic.

Improving the education and training environment is a continuous issue for us, and quality and research will always be among our priorities.

Providing in-service training; We attach more importance to in-service training in order to increase the capabilities of our staff who will work within the Faculty Secretariat of our Dean's Office.

Elimination of hardware deficiency; The Dean's Office aims to complete most of the deficiencies in technological equipment, stationery, and fixtures, especially computers, that disrupt the execution of business.

Providing appropriate education and training environments and other deficiencies necessary for our staff to work comfortably and efficiently will be among our priorities in the following years.
