

# Graduation Guidelines – 2026

## 1. Checking Curriculum Status

All students must check their **Curriculum Status (Müfredat Durumu)** through the OBS system. The Curriculum Status screen lists all courses in your program and shows whether they have been successfully completed.

- Every course marked with **"Z" (Zorunlu / Mandatory)** must be passed. For example, CENG400 and CENG401 are mandatory courses.
- No course in your curriculum may remain in a **failed** status at the time of graduation. Even if the course is an elective (e.g., CENG427 in the image above), a failed grade will prevent graduation.
- If an elective course is failed, you must either repeat the same course or replace it with another approved elective. This replacement must be arranged in consultation with your academic advisor during course registration or course add/drops.

## 2. Mandatory Requirements

To be eligible for graduation, students must complete all of the following:

- All mandatory courses listed in the OBS Curriculum Status
- **Two internships** (total of 8 credits, included in the 240 credits required for graduation)
- **Two Graduation Project courses**
- **Occupational Health and Safety Course**
  - If ENGR260 appears in your curriculum, one course is sufficient.
  - If ENGR265 and ENGR266 appear in your curriculum, both courses must be completed.

- **TDL101 and TDL102** (mandatory for all students, including international students)
  - **TIT101 and TIT102** (mandatory for all students, including international students)
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### 3. Elective Course Requirements

#### 3.1 University Elective (UE)

- **1 UE course – 6 credits in total**
- Language courses, ENGR electives, and CENG electives may be counted as UE.
- No additional action is required for CENG or ENGR courses to be counted as UE.

#### 3.2 Faculty Elective (ENGR)

- **2 or 3 ENGR courses – minimum 8 credits in total**
- CENG courses may be counted as ENGR electives.

Acceptable examples:

- 1 ENGR + 1 CENG (8 credits)
- 3 ENGR (9 credits)
- 2 CENG (10 credits)

No additional action is required for CENG courses to be counted as ENGR electives.

But as an example if you took CENG course instead of ENGR then do not count that course for your CENG electives (10 CENG).

#### 3.3 Department Elective (CENG)

- **10 CENG electives – 50 credits in total**
  - If you have not taken the mandatory “Signals and Systems” course which is closed but some of you might took before, **CENG327 cannot be counted** as a CENG elective, even if it appears as such in the system.
  - Approved elective courses from the Mathematics or Software Engineering departments may be counted as CENG department electives without any additional procedure.
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### 4. Graduation Rules

- All mandatory courses must be successfully completed.
  - A total of **10 CENG elective courses** must be completed.
  - At least **240 credits** must be accumulated.
    - If all course categories are completed but the total credit is below 240, additional UE, ENGR, or CENG electives must be taken.
  - All courses in the transcript must be in **English**, except TIT and TDL courses.
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## 5. Frequently Asked Questions

**Q1: The credit of a course has changed and I now have missing credits. What should I do?** You must take additional UE, ENGR, or CENG elective courses to complete the required total credits.

**Q2: I completed all courses but still have missing credits.** You are required to take extra elective courses (UE, ENGR, or CENG) until you reach at least 240 credits but there can be more than 240 credits.

**Q3: All courses are completed but I have one or two internships left.** You may complete your internships independently of the academic semester. After finishing the internship, submit your documents to the Internship Committee. The committee will process the grade entry in OBS; you do not need to wait for the next semester.

**Q4: What is the maximum duration for graduation?**

- Standard undergraduate students: **14 semesters**
  - Students admitted via DGS Exam: **10 semesters**
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## 6. Graduation Application and Diploma Process

1. After all grades are entered into OBS, submit a **Graduation Application** through the OBS system.
  2. Follow the instructions on the AYBU Student Affairs website:
    - Navigate to **Graduation → Graduation Process → Graduation Process for Short-Cycle & Bachelor Students**
    - Complete all required steps listed on the page.
  3. After the necessary approvals, your temporary graduation certificate will be available through the e-Government system within approximately **1–2 weeks**.
  4. For the official diploma:
    - You will receive an email from Student Affairs (usually within **1–2 months**).
    - Make an appointment as instructed and collect your diploma.
