Course Content and Objectives	<p>Course Content:</p> <p>ENG101 Academic English I is a foundational course designed for first-year undergraduate students to develop essential academic literacy skills. The course aims to advance students' critical thinking, analytical reasoning, and effective communication skills across multiple modalities. Students will engage with authentic academic materials on contemporary global issues, strengthening their ability to comprehend, analyse, and respond to complex ideas – competencies crucial for academic success and future professional development.</p> <p>ENG101 provides integrated instruction and practice, specifically focusing on reading and listening skills and knowledge of academic vocabulary. Through structured practice in critical reading, active listening, and academic discussion, students will build confidence in navigating diverse academic discourses and develop transferable skills applicable to their specific disciplines.</p> <p>Course Objectives:</p> <p>Students will be able to (i) critically analyse academic texts and multimedia content using strategic comprehension techniques, (ii) deploy academic vocabulary effectively in both written and spoken contexts, (iii) engage confidently in academic discussions using evidence-based reasoning, and (iv) demonstrate improved proficiency in academic English skills through integrated assessment tasks, and (v) reflect critically on the content and their learning through written and oral responses.</p>
