First report on EU related courses and on teaching mobility

September 2017- May 2018.

1. Development of EU Studies at YBU since Academic Year 2013-17

European Union studies at YBU started in February 2013, with the implementation of three courses: 1) “European Union Policies”, 2) “Theories of European Integration”, both taught by the prof. Angelo Santagostino; and 3) “EU Foreign and Security Policy” taught by Assoc. Prof. Giray Sadik.

The second step has been the transfer of the ad-personam Jean Monnet Chair, held by Prof. Angelo Santagostino, from Brescia University to YBU.

As third step the Chair submitted and had approved the program “Building bridges to Europe and to the World”, realized between 2014 and 2017

The fourth step has been the setting up by YBU, in November 2015, within the Faculty of Political Sciences of an “European Union Studies Application and Research Centre”.

The fifth step has been the submission, in February 2017, of an application (firstly submitted in February 2016) for an EU Centre of Excellence. The preparation of this proposal (Heart of Anatolia European Centre of Excellence) has led the Chair holder to get in touch with other universities and scholars in EU studies. In these opportunities, the Chair holder has promoted the Jean Monnet Action and highlighted the importance of re-energizing EU studies in Turkey.

2. Actions of ANAMER: September 2017 – May2018.

A few changes in respect to the application: 1) The course *Globalisation and the EU as an economic actor at the European Studies* has been taught by YK instead of SŞ; 2) *EU Employment Policy and Free Movement of Labour*, has been introduced; 3) Two courses, *European Neighbourhood Policy* and *EU Enlargement Strategy* have not been delivered.
