

The **EUROPEAN CLINICAL ETHICS NETWORK(ECEN)**, established in 2005, consists of an European Network of clinical ethics experts in practice, research, and training within the field of Clinical Ethics Support Services (such as Clinical Ethics Committees, Clinical Ethics Consultations, and Moral Deliberation). One of its aims is to further improve the quality and professional competence of those involved in Clinical Ethics Support Services (CESS) in Europe and internationally.

The ECEN Summer School will be a good opportunity to stimulate exchanges and future cooperation among European and International colleagues. It will thereby contribute to another ECEN goal: to share experiences and stimulate critical reflection on the field of Clinical Ethics Support Services in order to contribute to professional quality.
