Introduction

Briefing materials for previous EMS symposia were published in hard copy. This symposium marks a shift to an electronic-only format because it:

- Is cost-effective;
- Allows the inclusion of longer articles and video material that could not be included in a hard copy of acceptable length;
- Eliminates the environmentally harmful practises of printing and courier shipping (as recommended in ex post review of the 2017 symposium on *Health and the Environment in Emerging Markets*);
